### **Article 8 Competitor Eligibility.**

d) Crews entering the NSWRC or ECCRS do not need to be registered to score points

### **Article 10 Entry Fees.**

c) Entries close for the NSWRC, ECCRS, ACTRS and Mike Bell trophy entrants on May 2nd 2019

For Drivers who are registered in the NSWRC and ECCRS a discount of \$35.00 will apply.

### **Article 11 Servicing and Refuelling**

#### **Remote Refuel.**

In addition to refuelling, competitors are permitted to fit a maximum of two new tyres carried by service crew to their competition vehicles. They may also “front to back” existing tyres if desired. A maximum of 2 service crew members are permitted to assist the team with refuel and tyre change. The vehicle may only be refuelled once all four wheels are flat on the ground. The service crew may bring in a trolley jack, chassis stands, wheel nut spanners, rattle gun and a torque wrench. Additional time of 10 mins has been allowed for in the target time.

### **Article 14 Vehicle Advertising.**

Competitors entering the NSWRC and/or the ECCRS must display Rally NSW vehicle signage as per appendix I of the event regulations in order to score points.
